

詩篇2篇10節の הַשְׁכִּיל の意味
—ドラマの談話分析の視点から—

ABSTRACT Tetsuo SASAKI. “The Meaning of הַשְׁכִּיל in Psalm 2:10 : Bsed on Discourse Analysis of Drama”. The word of הַשְׁכִּיל in Ps. 2:10 is translated in various ways as “be wise”(RSV), “think carefully” (Craigie), “act prudently”(Briggs) and so on. When a discourse analysis of drama is applied to Psalm 2, we have the structure: narration (vv. 1-2), narrator’s interior monologue (v. 3), narration (vv. 4-5), the speech of the Lord (v. 6), the speech of the Anointed One (v. 7a, b), the quoting of the speech of the Lord by the Anointed One (v. 7c-9), narration (vv. 10-12c) and the closing narration (v. 12d). Using this analysis, we can determine the narrator’s intention in vv. 10-12c and thus the meaning of הַשְׁכִּיל more definitely; that is, that not only the metaphysical understanding in the mind but also the actual behavior is intended by the word הַשְׁכִּיל; in other words, the obedience to the Lord and the Anointed One is required of hearers.
