

## 初期ユダヤ文書における創造物語と唯一神信仰

**ABSTRACT** Masanobu ENDO, “Creation and Monotheism in Early Jewish Writings.” This paper examines Jewish theological concerns in contexts where reference is made to the Genesis creation account. Reference to the creation account appears in both sapiential and eschatological contexts. In sapiential contexts, the unique identity of God is the focus, and monotheistic teaching is developed, whereas in eschatological contexts, the realization of eschatological salvation is strongly expected on the grounds of the sovereignty of God, which is known in his work of creation. This observation on the relationship between the creation motif and Jewish monotheism may shed light on the theological framework of the Johannine prologue (particularly John 1:1-5) in which reference is made to the Genesis creation account.
