## 詩篇18篇の未完了形同士と継続法ワウの用法 一第2サムエル記22章との比較から一

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ABSTRACT Shigeo TAKEUCHI, "The Usage of the Imperfect with and without the Consecutive <u>waw</u> in Psalm 18 in Comparison with 2 Samuel 22." A comparison of Psalms 18 and 2 Samuel 22 reveals that some of the imperfect with and without the consecutive <u>waw</u> denote a perfective (not perfect) aspect which "indicates the view of a situation as a single whole" (Comrie). The <u>waw</u>-consecutive imperfect, however, mainly represents a temporal and/or logical (con)sequence, while the non-<u>waw</u>-imperfect signifies simultaneity or simply describes an event without a temporal idea.
